FOSTER HOME REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Cats/kittens are to remain indoors only. If outside, then in a secure enclosure or in a harness.
- 2. If renting, be able to provide proof that cats are allowed and deposits paid.
- 3. Be available for home visits from FF volunteers & applicants interested in adopting one of your foster kittens/cats. If applicants cannot come to your home then you must be available to bring them to the halfway house or other location for a meet & greet.
- 4. Use only the food and litter provided by FF unless approved prior by FF.
- 5. Be available to take your cat/kittens to appointments as scheduled by FF.
- 6. Be available to take cat/kittens to pet showings at least twice during the month.
- 7. Notify FF of developing behavior or physical issues that may be of concern.
- 8. Be willing and able to spend the time necessary to socialize and play with your fosters.
- 9. Be available to supervise all child interactions with the foster cat/kittens.
- 10. Give at least 10 days to 2 weeks notice if foster care can no longer be provided.
- 11. Be diligent in updating and recording any medical procedure done while in your care.
- 12. Return all documents, food, litter, medications, bedding, etc. belonging to FF when the cat/kitten is adopted or returned to FF care.
- 13. Be available to assist FF adoption counselors with applications and delivery.

We recommend, for your own protection, that all volunteers in contact with cats/kittens have a current tetanus vaccination

Furry Friends reserves the right to refuse fostering at any time.
