From January 1 to November 11, we placed 577 cats and kittens. We continue to get busier and busier. We are on track for adopting more than 600 cats and kittens this year.




Furry Friends Celebrates #GivingTuesday Pledging to Raise \$10k for Medical Expenses.

Tuesday November 28, Furry Friends hopes to raise at least \$10k for the medical expenses incurred by the many kittens and cats in our care. #GivingTuesday is recognized globally as a day of giving, harnessing the collective power of individuals, communities and organizations with the intent of encouraging philanthropy and celebrating generosity worldwide. Because Furry Friends is a no-kill cat rescue, our medical costs are extraordinarily high. In 2022 we spent more than \$250,000 caring for 506 cats and kittens. This does NOT include the additional 1,200-1,500 cats that our Pet Pantry provides food for each year.

Rosie's Medical Story

Rosie came to us as a tiny kitten in early April. Right away we could tell something wasn't right about one of her hips. Her leg just dangled and she dragged it along when she walked. We thought maybe it was dislocated. Upon getting x-rays, we learned she was essentially born without a hip socket on that side. It was recommended we wait to do any medical procedures until she grew since, at that time, she weighed only 1.5 lbs.

As Rosie grew, we noticed a few other medical issues. She had an umbilical hernia which was repaired during her spay but needed to be re-done afterwards as the hernia came back a month later. She later had a nasal polyp, also removed, but has grown back, and she has a polyp in her ear. We also found that her other hip socket was not formed properly. Consequently, she will need to have surgery on both hips. Total hip replacements are out of the question. Even if we had the funds, there are no surgeons in this area who do them. The second option is to have bilateral FHO (femoral head ostectomy) surgeries.






