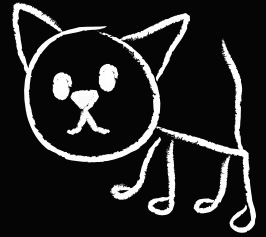


How You Can Help Furry Friends

Volunteer

Volunteer your time or resources to help Furry Friends. There are many ways you can help homeless cats outside of adoption.

Foster Care allows us to save a greater number of cats. Get your kitty fix by welcoming a cat into your home for a few weeks or a few months. Fostering is a great way to help on your own time and in the comfort of your own home. We supply the food, litter and medical, and you supply the love.

Shifts at HH or the Adoption Center at PetSmart in Hazel Dell, last from one to two hours once a week. Typical duties include feeding, watering, cleaning and playing with kitties.

Fundraising Events are vital to our mission. We need volunteers to be at the table or booth for our fundraising events. Tasks include answering questions, handing out literature or offering an ear to the many cat stories we hear from the public.

Adoption Events are a great way for the public to meet the cats. Volunteers are needed to educate the public on being a responsible cat owner, and to help with transporting and setting up at PetSmart-Hazel Dell, Pet Pros, and Esther Short Park adoption events.

Here are other ways to volunteer:

- Transport cats for veterinary visits
- Community education
- Newsletter
- Mailings
- Licensed vet tech for in-house medical
- Annual dinner auction
- Grant writing and managing
- Socializing one-on-one with cats
- Retrieve and return voicemail or email messages once a day/week
- Trap feral and stray cats, transport for altering, and return to caregiver
- Take your dog or cat to visit a senior facility for pet therapy.
- Yard work at HH
