Happy New Year!!! We hope that the holidays were merry and bright for you and your furry friends. We are wrapping up the year on a high note. We have adopted out over 600 cats and kittens--unheard of for us. As we continue to grow, we have had many successful events to help support all these cats.



Adoptions

From January 1 to December 21, we placed 645 cats and kittens, and we are still counting. The year isn't quite over. We expect to reach 650 adoptions by January 1. Our success is more than how many cats we can move, it is always about the welfare of each cat. They all get the same great medical and emotional care as we have always given, and we carefully match each cat to their adopting family.

Furry Friends is proud to announce that we received \$4,000 from Wilco's Boots & Blues Bag benefit. We were nominated to participate in this event and chosen to be the Washington State recipient. Thank you so much Wilco for helping out so many kitties with this award! Wilco's fourth annual Boots & Blues Bag Benefit Sale, which raises funds for local non-profits, took place October 24-26, 2023, in all 25 Wilco Farm Store locations in Oregon, Washington and California. Wilco asked customers to name and vote on the programs that they wanted to benefit from the sale of bags. Over the summer, hundreds of local non-profits were suggested, and customers were able to vote. Based on the social media fan nominations, Furry Friends was one of the three non-profit organizations selected.




2023 Year End FF President's Report

We have faced many challenges—and many successes--throughout the year, but the one thing that has always shined through is our commitment to the cats in our care. We started the year with a goal to rescue as many cats as possible, and we are proud to say that we have exceeded our expectations. We have rescued hundreds of cats and kittens from many different situations and found loving homes for them.

We have focused on injured, ill and stray cats, and on hoarding situations. When we decided to direct our efforts on cats that were most in need, we found amazing improvements in the lives of the cats we saved. Focusing on the neediest not only helped the cats, it also provided valuable education to animal owners and the community about the importance of spay/neuter and reaching out for help. As of December, we have adopted more than 600 cats and kittens, another record-breaking year. 
