## FOSTER HOME REQUIREMENTS

1. Cats/kittens are to remain indoors only. If outside, then in a secure enclosure or in a harness.
2. If renting, be able to provide proof that cats are allowed and deposits paid.
3. Be available for home visits from FF volunteers & applicants interested in adopting one of your foster kittens/cats. If applicants cannot come to your home then you must be available to bring them to the halfway house or other location for a meet & greet.
4. Use only the food and litter provided by FF unless approved prior by FF.
5. Be available to take your cat/kittens to appointments as scheduled by FF.
6. Be available to take cat/kittens to pet showings at least twice during the month.
7. Notify FF of developing behavior or physical issues that may be of concern.
8. Be willing and able to spend the time necessary to socialize and play with your fosters.
9. Be available to supervise all child interactions with the foster cat/kittens.
10. Give at least 10 days to 2 weeks notice if foster care can no longer be provided.
11. Be diligent in updating and recording any medical procedure done while in your care.
12. Return all documents, food, litter, medications, bedding, etc. belonging to FF when the cat/kitten is adopted or returned to FF care.
13. Be available to assist FF adoption counselors with applications and delivery.

## **VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES**

Are you interested in volunteering with Furry Friends? Please check the areas you may be interested in. If you're not interested at this time, please skip this section

**Halfway House Assistant:** One-to two-hour shift once a week morning or evening; must follow house procedures and protocols; must be dependable (the cats rely on you); clean litter boxes; wash/dry bedding; sweep/vacuum/mop; feed/water; give medications; play/socialize cats.

**Foster Care:** Provide safe, stress-free, healthy home environment to socialize and love kittens and cats while you prepare them for a forever home. Transport to medical appointments and adoption events. Food and supplies will be provided.

**Adoption Center:** One-to two-hour shifts once a week, morning or evening, at Hazel Dell PetSmart; clean litter boxes, sweep, feed/water, play/socialize cats. Minimum age 18.

**Adoption Events:** Time commitment varies; transport cats and supplies to local events; be friendly, outgoing and professional with the public; must work as a team.

**Special Events:** Staff a table at an event; answer questions and distribute Furry Friends information; be friendly, outgoing and professional with the public.

**Therapy Pet Visits:** One-hour visit once a month at select senior facilities with your vaccinated and temperament tested pet.
