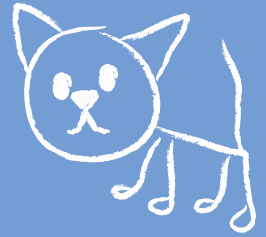


How You Can Help Furry Friends

Volunteer

Volunteer your time or resources to help Furry Friends. There are many ways you can help homeless cats outside of adoption.

Foster Care allows us to save a greater number of cats. Get your kitty fix by welcoming a cat or litter of kittens into your home for a few weeks or a few months.

Shifts at the Halfway House last about two hours or so once a week. Typical duties include feeding, watering, cleaning and playing with kitties.

Fundraising Events are vital to our mission. We need volunteers to be at the table or booth for our fundraising events.

Adoption Events are a great way for the public to meet the cats. Volunteers are needed to educate the public on being a responsible cat owner, and to help with transporting cats and setting up.
